



The Alex Reser Scholarship at The Reser Family Foundation

The Reser Family Foundation was formed to honor the legacy of family values and community involvement cherished by the Reser Family. Founded by the Reser Family, the Foundation was granted charitable status in 2010 and awarded their first grants in 2011. Today, the Foundation partners with diverse organizations across Oregon to strengthen the people and places that makes Oregon so unique and inspiring.

The Reser Family believes in the value of education and is providing a scholarship to honor Alex Reser and to support a High School Senior who has been involved in wrestling during High School to support them as they attend college.

Here are the details:

Scholarship Name: The Alex Reser Scholarship at The Reser Family Foundation



Alex Reser - 1988 to 2019

Alex was raised in Beaverton and graduated from Westview High School. He was a talented athlete, loved baseball and wrestling and followed his passion as a wrestler at Oregon State University. He graduated in 2012 with a degree in accounting, achieved his CPA accreditation and worked as a manager for Moss Adams Accounting Company.

Alex was caring, loyal, and warm hearted. He was a trusted son, brother, friend, and uncle. His passions were skiing, wakeboarding, OSU athletics and spending time with his family and friends. He was also an avid movie watcher and loved to quote movie phrases.

Award Process: Students send their application via email to the Oregon Wrestling Association. The Oregon Wrestling Association Scholarship Committee selects the recipient and notify The Reser Family Foundation. Scholarship Committee's family members are not eligible for the scholarship. The scholarship is presented at the Senior Awards Assembly by a Reser Family Foundation Member annually in June at the student's High School.

Guidelines/Criteria:

1. This scholarship is available for an Oregon high school senior who will be attending an accredited university that provides a baccalaureate degree.
2. The recipient must be a high school senior that was a Wrestling Athlete during their High School Career.
3. The Reser Family Foundation will be notified of the recipient and provided proof of enrollment at the College. The Reser Family Foundation will administer the funds and send award checks directly to the university. The recipient is required to sign a letter of acknowledgement provided by The Reser Family Foundation.
4. The required minimum GPA is 3.50.
5. Amount: \$10,000.00.
6. Involvement in leadership and community where they live is preferred.
7. The Oregon Wrestling Committee is responsible for the selection of the Scholarship Recipient and for notifying The Reser Family Foundation regarding the name and contact information of the recipient.
8. A Thank You Letter to The Reser Family Foundation from the recipient is expected within 1 month of being selected for the Scholarship.
9. Follow Up/Impact letter from the recipient to The Reser Family Foundation is expected within 1 year of receiving the scholarship funds.

Scholarship Process:

1. The Oregon Wrestling Association will notify coaches at the annual Wrestling Coaches Training in March regarding the scholarship and application process.
2. The coaches will talk with the Wrestlers that are High School Seniors and interested students will fill out an application, due via email by April 21st each year to The Oregon Wrestling Association - oregonwrestling.usaw@gmail.com
3. The Scholarship Committee at The Oregon Wrestling Association will review the applications and determine the recipient.
4. The scholarship committee will email the recipient's name to The Foundation by the end of May annually to (marijo@thereserfamilyfoundation.org) along with the recipient's application.
5. A Reser Family Foundation Member will present the award at the Senior Awards Assembly in June and provide the acknowledgement form to the recipient.
6. The Foundation will receive acceptance/enrollment paperwork from the recipient by July 15, 2024 confirming the school they are attending.
7. The check will be sent directly to the university.
8. The recipient will receive a copy of the check.
9. The Foundation will receive a thank you letter from the recipient by July 15, 2024.
10. The Student will send an impact letter at the end of the college school year - by June 30. 2024.
